





The Justice Support Foundation affiliated with the Arab Center for the Independence of Judiciary and Legal Profession (ACIJLP) holds the international community responsible for the ongoing 24/7 crimes committed in the Jabalia camp, which was targeted today to force its residents to migrate to southern Gaza which accounts for war crimes.

Today, October 31, 2023, around 2 p.m., the Israeli occupation forces' warplanes bombarded Area no. 6 of the highly populated Jabalya camp, resulting in more than 400 deaths and injuries, so far most of them are women and children, leaving the residential square of the camp fully destroyed. At a time when the Palestinian Civil Defense Authority and the ambulance services are suffering an almost total destruction, making it impossible for civil defense teams to rescue the victims under the rubble of homes targeted by the Israeli occupation forces.

It is noteworthy that the residents of Jabalya camp determined to remain in their homeland after the suffering they experienced while trying to flee to the south and seek refuge in the UNRWA relief camps.

ACIJLP declares that the indiscriminate bombardment of residential areas with Palestinian civilians committed by the Israeli occupation forces represents war crimes and crimes against humanity, in accordance with the provisions of the Fourth Geneva Convention and the Statute of the International Criminal Court (ICC).

ACIJLP, accordingly, calls on the international community to hold accountable for its responsibilities, towards an immediate ceasefire, to force the Israeli occupation to open border crossings to bring in aid, immediately without hindrance, and to end the Gaza Strip blockade in order to stop the crimes committed against Palestinian civilians.
